Jamboree:

- We discussed moving the food vendor location at the Playa, so the food vendors can run their generators at night to keep food fresh.

- There will be more porta potties and they will be placed differently this year.
- There will be a kid raffle for kids 12 & under, we have 2 VW power Wheels and games to raffle. Tickets will be .25 or 5 for a \$1.00. Darla will be bringing a bus up to the Jamboree for the kids to paint.
- Sean, at the Playa, is going to help us find a medical company to be at the Playa during the Jamboree since Medstar's prices increased considerably for this year.
- This year, at the Jamboree, there will be a lantern walk for Andy (Drew) Kunz, Knate Ostenso and Sean Wright (Gilmore Enterprises) as a memorial for them.
- Last year's Jamboree the generator was rented for \$600.00. Rob reached out to SHP, Joe Genovese, and SHP will be loaning us a generator, delivering it to the Playa with extra gas. Per Joe SHP will loan us the generator every year.
- Natalie getting stickers and magnets for the Jamboree. Jamboree event shirts will be purchased for a reasonable price.
- Kettle Corn vendor will donation 50 to 100 bags of kettle corn that we can sell.
- Sue Rice spoke to Food Vendor Michelle to inform her that we are expecting more people this year at the Jamboree and may need another food vendor. Michelle gave Sue Rice some names of other food vendors. Sandi will reach out to a BRBQ vendor.
- New Banner with event pricing will be ordered to hang at the entry gate.
- Directions to the Playa will be simplified on the ABC website.

Jamboree raffle prizes are needed. If anyone knows of a company or restaurant that can donate gift cards this would be helpful or any other items.

A motorcycle backpack has been donated and will be shipped to the club.

Raffle Bus is coming along. Russell is great with the work flow on the bus. Russell has been in communication with Jeremy regarding the upholstery projects. Brakes, front & rear suspension need to be installed. Engine is ready to be picked up. The Raffle Bus should be ready in approximately 3 weeks. Reach out to Brian to be added to the WhatsApp to sign up to work on the bus.

BUSES & BREWS was 4/05/25 at Four Peaks Wilson Street Brewery. Joy Bus was the charity that the proceeds of \$1000.00 were donated to. It was discussed changing the date next year due to there

were back to back to back car shows this year. We are hoping to have more clubs join the car show next year.

Jamboree 35 raffle bus will be purchased from Andy (Drew) Kunz's parents, 1966 Splitty Walk Through Bus. The club reached out to Drew's parents and they have agreed to accepting \$7500.00 now and the balance will be paid in October. Mike & Rob picked up the bus on Saturday, 4/12/25. Including the purchase price it may cost 20K – 25K to restore the bus. The last split raffle bus was won by Darla in 2016.

Miller & Sue deMar will be having a "THANK YOU BRBQ" for all the people who volunteered and helped out at the Jamboree #33.

Current members are 134. There are 12 new members since the beginning of the year. There are 4 ways to join the club on the website. Two new members were at the meeting: Scott was a member years ago he joined the club again and has 6 buses, Rick has joined and has a 68 transporter.
