This is the last meeting before the Jamboree. If needed, the Board will have a zoom meeting to discuss last minute details for the Jamboree.

Meeting with the City of Prescott went well, we have the permit to hold the Jamboree in Prescott. Regarding hanging banners in the town of Prescott was addressed at the meeting: it costs \$200.00, we must find a private person's property to hang a banner and pay for someone to hang them. We will be hanging banners ourselves around the outside of the rodeo grounds.

There will be a cash bar at the Jamboree. Campers that bring their own alcohol need to keep it at their campsite and use discretion when walking around, use a solo cup.

½ off entry for all previous Raffle Bus winners. We will organize a picture of all the buses, in front of the stage, at the Jamboree.

So far there are 5 vendors for vendor row, the vendor form is on the website for anyone that interested on being a vendor (no food vendors) at the Jamboree. We have 3 food trucks, coffee truck, a band for Friday night and a band for Saturday night.

Bus Club Member, Darla, will put a post on FB that someone can drive her split window bus to the Jamboree and camp in it. This is the last split window raffle bus won at a Jamboree; Darla won it in 2016. Darla will also allow the kids to paint her other bus at the Jamboree.

The board will be renting a U-Haul to bring up the sound system, stage, corn hole boards, raffle prizes and many other items. The Raffle Bus will be trailered to the Jamboree.

The board rented 3 corn hole boards, Rob, Miller and Greg will be bringing corn hole boards as well.

Some board members will be going up to the Prescott Rodeo Grounds on Tuesday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, to start chalking the lines. There are a limited amount of people allowed up on Tuesday so some members will be coming up early on Wednesday to help with set-up.

Raffle prizes are needed; we haven't received responses from companies we have reached out to.

Prescott Antique Car Club is having an open house, at the Prescott Rodeo Grounds during the Jamboree. This club will have a restored fire truck as well as other vehicles. There is also a corvette show the same weekend as the Jamboree. Hopefully people will attend our event as well.

October General Meeting we will have nominations for new board members for 2027 board.

The club has tried to have a camp out at Seven Springs for several years now, in March, and due to bad weather, the camp outs have been canceled. David Kelly will put something together for a campout for next year for club members.
