## Jamboree Rules of Conduct

- Noise curfew at campsite is 10:00 PM until 7:00 AM.
- No loud music, drums or yelling
- **IMPORTANT!** Gas powered generators (quiet inverter type) are permitted, but they must be shut down by 10:00 PM (quiet time) without exception.
- VWs & RVs must have a fire extinguisher.
- **Propane Fire Pits ONLY**, per Prescott Rodeo Grounds rules.
- No motorized vehicles are allowed on event roads after setup with the exception of an electric bike. Please keep it at 5 mph.
- For safety reasons, all personal items including, but not limited to camping gear, VW vehicles, swap items, propane fire pits, etc. must stay around your designated camp area.
- You will be provided with trash bags. Everything that you pack in must leave with you at the end of the event. Please dump your trash in the provided dumpster on site.
- Polite and quiet pets are welcome! Dogs must be on a leash at all times and please pick up after your pets. Bags will be provided.
- Aerial luminaries (Sky Lanterns) and Fireworks are **PROHIBITED**
- Simply be kind to your neighbors!
- Gates are open from 8:00 AM until 10:00 PM
- You can swap from your camp spot
- You must limit the area used to swap to your camp spot. Space is limited due to the expected number of VW campers

- You cannot set up like a vendor in your camp spot, if you feel you need more area to swap you can set up a swap spot in the main swap meet area
- ABC personnel and camp guards will be patrolling the area.
- Be polite and respectful to all Volunteering staff and crew members. Please listen to them and do as you are asked to ensure the success of the event and the safety of those who attend.
- Please keep food/drinks at your campsite.
- Alcohol will be available for purchase on Friday and Saturday.
- No outside alcohol is allowed pursuant to the Prescott Rodeo Grounds.
- The Arizona Bus Club does not condone underage drinking or the use of any illegal substances at this event.

By entering the premises, you agree to these Rules of Conduct. The Arizona Bus Club reserves the right to eject anyone for violating the Rules of Conduct, destroying property or creating a disturbance. We are all here to have a good time. Please practice good, safe camping habits, and be nice.
